31 Oct 1918. My Dearest Mother, I am writing this in a smoky cellar..... It's a great life... There is no danger down here. Or if there is it will be over before you read these lines..... Of this I am certain: you could not be visited by a band of friends half so fine as those who surround me here. (To Sassoon) Dearest Friend, Some poems to tempt you to a letter.... And I'll give you my mother's address. I know you would try to see her — if I fail to see her again.

This special performance of Not About Heroes is by invitation of the Wilfred Owen Association and the Mayor of Ors, Jacky Duminy, and combines an inspirational two day all inclusive trip to Ypres and Ors.

Not About Heroes is a play for today. An exquisite exploration of love, courage and humanity set against the backdrop of the First World War. It tells the story of Wilfred Owen meeting Siegfried Sassoon at Craiglockhart War Hospital and the friendship that transforms them both, creating some of the twentieth century's greatest war poetry. Both men return to the front. Sassoon is shot in the head but survives, Owen is machine gunned to death on the 4th Nov 1918 at the Sombre Oise Canal. The play includes the re-creation of Owen's last letter home (above) written at the Forrester's House, now the Wilfred Owen Memorial.

- Arrive Maidstone 7pm Manchester midnight
